

KKM Service Team & Check-In Leaders (STL) NEW!

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

A STL should be a growing believer who has been given the spiritual gifts of hospitality, helps, administration and/or encouragement. They are the appointed GO TO person for a designated ministry time slot; nursery through 5th grades.

Commitment: Rotating Schedule – Choose One: One or two services per month

Tasks: To set a positive example for others by living as an authentic witness of Christ.

To welcome and encourage teachers, helpers, parents and children as they arrive. This position helps set the stage for a smooth transition time between services.

To take care of simple and basic set up/shut down for the FX Room, 1st service.

To help with Check-In, serving food (Saturdays only) and at times may be needed to help troubleshoot any material and staffing needs in each department.

To take charge and help switch staff from different departments to insure we meet volunteer-to-child ratios.

On occasion, to be a substitute helper in a classroom for the day as needed.

To pray regularly for the KK ministry team.

To attend Kreek Kids training and team building activities.
(Activities usually held 2-4 events a year)

KKM Child Safety & Check-In Team Member

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

The Safety & Check-In Members is someone who greets and welcomes families as they arrive at the Kreek Kids Check-In Center. Their primary responsibility is to help implement safety and check-in procedures in our KK program, 0-5th grades.

Commitment: Rotating Schedule – Choose One: One or two services per month

Tasks:

To welcome families and help sign children in and out of their classrooms safely

To implement Safety and Check-In Basics (Posted in Check-In - review regularly)

To share safety issues or Check-In concerns with the Check-In Director.

Upon leaving, set up Check-In area with correct clipboards/signs for the NEXT services.

To leave a note for Director when restocking of name labels and supplies are needed such as:

- Registration Cards, Sign In Sheets
- Name Tags, Pens and Supplies
- General First Aid and Safety Items

To attend Kreek Kids training and team building activities.
(Activities usually held 2-4 events a year)

KKM Nursery/Toddler Team Member

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

The Nursery/Toddler Team Member supports the Kreek Kids mission and helps implement the nursery or toddler Department Basics (posted in room) on Saturday or Sunday mornings.

Commitment: Rotating Schedule – Choose One: One or two services per month

Tasks include:

- Helping to create a warm and welcoming atmosphere for families
- Interacting with parents who are arriving and exiting the department
- Securely check-in children and assign pager (when applicable)
- Calm, encourage and play with young children
- Implement basic sanitation and clean up procedures

To attend Kreek Kids training and team building activities.
(Activities usually held 2-4 events a year)

KKM Preschool/Kindergarten Teacher or Activity Leader

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

The Teacher and AL Leaders are growing believers who have the spiritual gifts of teaching, encouragement and/or creative communications. He or she is comfortable in an up-front role, energetic, and able to teach a medium or large group of children.

Commitment: Rotating Schedule – Choose One: One month on, two months off
One month on, one month off
Once or Twice per month

Tasks include:

Setting a positive example for others by living as an authentic witness of Christ.

- teaching the Bible creatively to the children
- help present live-action or puppet dramas
- lead the songs presented in the curriculum
- review biblical principles with games and activities provided in the program's curriculum; Pre Teach, Teach, Post Teach
- introduce and teach the key Bible verse for the lesson each week
- work with the Department Director and Resource Director to acquire materials and the teaching props for large group lessons, when needed
- preview and pray for each week's learning experience ahead of time

(Note: Visual teaching tools, videos, CD's and song overheads are provided, if needed)

KKM Preschool/Kindergarten Helper

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

The Preschool Helper – Supports the teacher or leader for the day by helping implement classroom activities.

Commitment: Rotating Schedule – Choose One: One month on, two months off
One month on, one month off
Once or Twice per month

Tasks include:

- help focus and calm our children while the teacher is talking
- encourage children to obey Kreek Kids minimum behavior rules
- you may be asked to help participate in live-action or puppet dramas
- participate and have fun with the songs presented in the curriculum
- be involved in activities that review biblical principles with games and activities provided in the program's curriculum; Pre Teach, Teach, Post Teach
- pray for our children and each week's learning experience ahead of time

KKM Video Tech 1st-5th Grades

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

The Video Tech supports our teaching teams by helping set up sound and video equipment for LIVE video feeds, DVD's, music, games and learning activities.

Video, computer and stereo knowledge helpful but not required.

Commitment: Rotating Schedule – Choose One: One month on, two months off
One month on, one month off
One or two services per month

Tasks include large group support such as:

- arriving 15-20 minutes prior to Connection service to set up video/sound feeds
- to start, monitor and adjust sound for video and DVD's as needed during teaching time
- to shut down video/sound equipment after lesson and activity time
- helping to focus and calm children while the teacher is talking
- encourage children to obey Kreek Kids minimum behavior rules
- be involved in activities when needed that review biblical principles with games and activities provided in the program's curriculum; Pre Teach, Teach, Post Teach
- pray for our children and each week's learning experience ahead of time

To attend Kreek Kids training and team building activities.
(Activities usually held 2-4 events a year)

KKM Substitute Helpers and Parent Partners

Kreek Kids exists to supplement the family in their attempt to build a spiritual foundation, so that in God's timing, will lead a child into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ.

Substitute Helpers and Parent Partners support the Kreek Kids mission by volunteering at one or two services per month. Some volunteers serve in whichever department needs them most during our weekend services.

Rotating Schedule Commitment: One or two services per month
